This complex multi layered ale has a floral hop aroma with medium bodied hop, bitter taste with some fruit and sweetness.

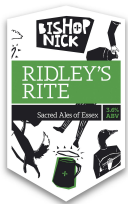
Golden - 3.9% - £3.00 154.1 Miles
